

The Youth Empowerment Project in nutshell

- The project aimed at improving the employability of youth, by providing demand-driven training in employability, entrepreneurial, ICT, and life skills, as well as assistance with placement in jobs and internships and development of new enterprises
- 2085 beneficiaries in two programs:
 - the employability training program “Passport to Employment”
 - the young entrepreneurs’ program ‘Empacto’
- Four locations in Dakar, Thiès, Saint-Louis and Kaolack
- Led by the Finnish Children and Youth Foundation, financed by MFA, implemented by Synapse Center



Evaluation methods

1. Desk study of project documents and other relevant data
2. Interviews of key informants in person in Finland and in Senegal, 8 interviewees
3. Focus groups for youth in Senegal, 91 participants
 - Four focus groups / PPE / Dakar, 47 participants; One focus groups / Empacto / Dakar, 15 participants; One focus group / Empacto / Guèdiawaye - suburbs of Dakar, 12 participants; One focus group / Empacto / Thiès, 11 participants; One focus group / Empacto / Saint-Louis, 6 participants
4. Standardized questionnaires for youth in Senegal, 99 respondents
 - PPE / Dakar, 48 respondents; Empacto / Dakar, 17 respondents; Empacto / Guèdiawaye - suburbs of Dakar, 16 respondents; Empacto / Thiès, 11 respondents; Empacto / Saint-Louis, 7 respondents
5. Most significant change (MSC) for youth in Senegal, 82 stories
 - PPE / Dakar, 43 stories
 - Empacto / Dakar, 12 stories
 - Empacto / Guèdiawaye - suburbs of Dakar, 13 stories
 - Empacto / Thiès, 10 stories
 - Empacto / Saint-Louis, 4 stories
6. Interviews of other stakeholder groups in Senegal, 15 interviewees
7. Facilitated workshops for project staff in Senegal, 7 participants


Lumière

2. Categorizing data

1. (Reading stories through: All stories except one praised the program strongly and listed various impacts the program had had on them.)

2. Organizing stories into similar categories
 - The strong positive changes in personality
 - Increased knowledge in techniques how to apply for employment or how to create and manage an enterprise



Category can be a common theme, interesting idea, repeating motif, significant issue or question that are emerging across the data

3. Analyzing data

Identifying main themes within categories

- Changes in personal development:
 - Self-confidence (I know that I can, I know that I am good)
 - Courage (to search and apply for a job, to speak up, to trust in oneself)
 - Self-knowledge (who I am and what I want to do)
- Increased knowledge in techniques:
 - How to make a business plan (Empacto)
 - How to manage the revenues and expenses of an enterprise (Empacto)
 - How to manage an enterprise in general (Empacto)
 - How to set goals and organize life (PPE)
 - How to write CV and motivation letter (PPE)
 - How to behave at work (PPE)



4. Interpreting data

Interpreting findings, assessing contributions to impacts, summarizing and drawing conclusions

~~The changes in personal development brought by the project can be divided into two capacities to different types of changes. Firstly, the participants reported about the strong positive changes in their personality with strengthened self-confidence, courage and self-knowledge.~~

~~Creating and managing enterprises (Impacto) and founding, getting and keeping jobs (PPE). Increased knowledge realized in how to apply for employment or how to create and manage an enterprise.~~

Secondly, the participants reported about the increased knowledge in techniques how to apply for employment or how to create and manage an enterprise. other spheres of lives of the young, not only enabling them to acquire an employment or creating enterprise, but to manage their lives in general. They had learnt who they are and what they want to do with their lives.

how to make a market research, knowledge on how markets work, how to get clients, how to behave in business world, how to do planning, how to be creative and having ideas, how to manage and maintain relations, and how to be ambitious and having a right attitude

EQ3 In which ways the entrepreneurship trainings address possibilities of young people to start up sustainable enterprises? How can the entrepreneurship trainings be developed?

The curriculum of life skills included lessons on self-esteem, independent learning, self-confidence, communication skills, team work, managing conflicts, organizational skills, and creativity, caring for one's overall health, personal presentation, taking responsibility, time management and ethics in workplace.

Youth will be equipped with transferable and marketable skills, which will give them direct access to long-term career opportunities and improved livelihoods.2. The project will support economic growth in key sectors in Senegal by supplying skilled, young people to the job market. It will also encourage employers to increase emphasis on training, and to contribute the professional development of youth.
The specific objective	To improve the employability and life opportunities of 2,200 disadvantaged, unemployed young people in Senegal. Participants will acquire employability, entrepreneurial, ICT, and life skills, as well as assistance with placement in jobs and internships and development of new enterprises.
